Greenhouse Frame Expansion

Jade plant (Called a "money grown tree; カネのなる木" in Japan) has been growing a lot every year (Am I getting lot of money?).

I made a sheet frame for placing a sheet covering over the jade plant not to get damaged by frost in winter.

In 2019, I expanded the sheet frame (the second generation) made by 3/4" PVC pipe with couplings because of the rapid growth.

This year (2023), I have expanded the frame (additional 20" both side & width as well as one more stay bar at top; the third generation) once more.

Cut 6 side bars

Brought out to wide area



6 side bars extension done



Cut 5 front and rear bars



Done, sufficient space (One size larger!) was made between jade plant and frame

Countermeasure for Rain



Ouch! Rain water was impounded working as a reservoir!

Putting a horizontally placed 8' x (2" x 2") lumber with a vertically placed 8" x (2" x 2") stay bar at center successfully resolved the problem.
