

## Repair Refrigerator


Although compressor is always working, temperature of both freezer and refrigerator seems not cooling down so much.




Ice Maker in Freezer Compartment



Ice Maker Removed




Putty on Cooling Fan Stopped Fan Rotation, Incurred No Forced Cooling Air Flow (Top of Freezer Compartment)

Putty on Cooling Fan




Other Putty Found near Evaporator

## Damper (Refrigerator Temperature Control)

Damper is mechanically moving flaps that controls opening space between freezer compartment and refrigerator compartment to control cold air flowing from freezer compartment to refrigerator compartment.

Refrigerator design seems to be bunch of low tech.
